- *Only Jesus can bear the weight of our worship
- *Worship isn't just music. It's an attitude
- *Worship happens when our view of God is elevated

- *What is your appetite for? What are you most hungry for?
- *What are some things that elevate your view of God (ex. Planet earth, how the body works, the Bible, etc...)?
